# HOME-SCHOOL AGREEMENT

## 1. The Parent/Carer

#### I / we shall:

- ensure that your child achieves their full potential, as a valued member of this Christian community.
- provide a balanced curriculum and meet the individual needs of your child.
- achieve high standards of work and behaviour through building good relationships and developing a sense of responsibility.
- keep parents informed about general school matters and your child's progress, attendance and punctuality.
- be open and welcoming, offering opportunities for parents/carers to discuss their concerns and to become involved in the life of the school.
- use the contact details provided by parents/carers.

## 3. The Pupil

### I shall:

- attend school regularly and on time.
- bring all the equipment I need every day to complete my lessons.
- wear the school uniform correctly and be tidy in appearance.
- do all my classwork and home learning as well as I can.
- be polite and helpful to others, acting sensibly with courtesy and consideration.
- observe all school rules and follow all staff instructions.
- respect other people's property.
- behave in an appropriate manner when travelling to and from school.
