Dear Parents, Carers and Year 11 students

The results day on August 12 will be hosted using our online Insight portal. Pupils will be able to login to Insight through the link on the school website. We aim to open the results at 9am for pupil access and at 10am for parents and carers. It is vital that your login details and passwords are functioning and we suggest that these are tested as soon as possible before August. Students will use their school login which uses the format [16holdenm@sarchs.com](mailto:16holdenm@sarchs.com) and parents should use the login and password registered with the school office. Passwords can be reset by contacting IT Support on 01254 828864.

I have attached an appeals information guide that outlines the process of how the Teacher Assessed Grades (TAGs) have been allocated this year and the appeals process that the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) has established for all schools. Please note that this year an appeal can have three outcomes: the grade can remain the same, changed to a higher grade or changed to a lower grade. An autumn series of examinations has also been announced should a student wish to sit an examination for individual or all subjects. Included in the guide sheet are the dates for which centre reviews and appeals to the awarding organisations must be requested. The link for the appeals document will also be active from the digital copy of the guide sheet which will also be available on the school website. The appeals document should be downloaded, completed and returned to school using the [exams@sarchs.com](mailto:exams@sarchs.com) email address.

Due to the requirement to keep pupil work until after the appeals process, we must advise that a student's art/graphics portfolios will not be available for collection until after 20 September. Please could I also ask that any books that have yet to be returned are dropped off to the school entrance in a bag including the student's name.

Details of the annual leavers' celebration evening will be finalised in September. We have set a provisional date for November 11, we hope that we will be able to welcome you into school to celebrate the achievements of our Year 11 students this year.
